
The Coloring Forest is a fun book to observe and color.

The book is a journey that invites, through illustration, the contemplation of scenes that happen inside the forest and the nearby town. You only need a box of colored pencils to give brightness and light to each page.

Light in material, it allows it to be easily transported by the child and have moments of aesthetic appreciation coloring each scene.

While the animals live in the forest in the first half of the book, in the other half, the townspeople can't seem to find them. Dozens of stories can be invented and colored freely since the book does not include any text other than a quote from Henri Matisse on the back cover.

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

This book, full of illustrated landscapes, invites children to have fun with the funny stories that happen at sea. In the first half of the book, readers will have fun coloring the dozens of stories that occur on the beach and on the surface of the sea, while in the second half, they will be able to dive to the bottom of the ocean to explore the marine fauna and flora as well as submarines and ships that hide treasures and adventures. The Sea is a journey that invites, through a line illustration, the contemplation of minute and inexhaustible details that can be illuminated with a box of colored pencils. Dozens of stories can be invented and intervened freely since the book does not contain any texts other than a quote from Jacques Cousteau on the back cover.





PIKABÚ SERIE

¡PIU! (Tweet!), ¡CRACK! (Crack!), ¡PUF! (Poop!) and ¡Ajá! (Sneak!) are the titles of a non-fiction book series that use poetry and humor. With their small, quadratic format, made of sturdy cardboard, and featuring a simple, robust pop-up mechanism, these books are very well-suited to be manipulated repeatedly, to be opened, read, and looked at.

Through verses as riddles, readers must discover to which bird, animal, or insect the feathers, eggs or poop belong. Every one gets two double-spreads and, charmingly, it is only after turning to the second page that we learn which animal is behind the feather, egg or poop just poetically described. The cheerful, funny pictures contribute to the playful, relaxed character of this book that introduces poetry -through riddles- to first readers. The final two pages briefly list additional information about each of the animals featured.


